

Zip'eMate instructions

When you use a Zip'eMate it's a bit confusing which plates you have to use and in which order. That's why I made the list below where I gave each plate its own letter. I wrote this letter on the plate with a permanent marker. Whatever you want to do with your "Zippy", it's easy to take the right plates in the right order. Please be aware that I wrote down the order that you take the plates. So you build up the pile from bottom to top. This could be a little unclear but that's how you use this device.

Platform/Mat	Name	Art.nr.	Appearance
Platform A	Platform Zip'eCuts/Sizzlits/QK	ZUP10A	White platform (2,6 cm thick)
Platform B	Platform Zip'eSlim/Sizzix dies	ZIPSZXP	White platform (1,2 cm thick)
Mat C	Full Cutting Mat	ZIPCMFA	Clear plexiglass mat
Mat D	Sizzlits Cutting Mat	ZSZLM	Thin milky white mat
Mat E	Embossing Foam	ZEF11A	Black soft foam
Mat F	Embossing Mat	ZEF12A	Halfclear non-flexible mat
Sheet G	Shim sheet		Very thin clear sheet

Die cut with the thin Zip-dies (Zip'eCuts) or the QuickKutz-dies

From bottom to top:

- Platform A
- The die with the foam side up
- Cardboard
- Mat C

Die cut with the thick Zip-dies (Zip'eSlim) or the Sizzix-dies

From bottom to top:

- Platform B
- The die with the foam side up
- Cardboard
- Mat C

Die cut with the Sizzlits-dies

From bottom to top:

- Platform A
- The die with the foam side up
- Cardboard
- Mat D

Emboss with a usual embossingtemplate

From bottom to top:

- Platform A
- Embossingtemplate
- Cardboard
- Mat E (let this mat stick out at the back about 1 cm!)
- Mat F (with the side with the bevelled edge up)

Emboss with Sizzix Simple Impressions

From bottom to top:

- Platform A
- Place the cardboard between the Simple Impression, metal side down
- Mat E

Attention: mat F will NOT be used!
